THE JMUCC EXPERIENCE

The John Molson Undergraduate Case Competition is an annual, multi-round case competition organized by a committee of students from the John Molson School of Business at Concordia University. Set in the heart of downtown Montreal, this exciting, week-long event brings together 24 undergraduate case competition teams from around the globe to showcase the talent and skills of their students for the last 15 years. For our 16th edition, we are extremely pleased to return to an in-person format and deliver an unforgettable experience event for all participants.

ACADEMIC

JMUCC offers participants unique, challenging, and dynamic cases paired with world-class networking opportunities and one-of-a-kind social events inspired by the city of Montreal. It is a once-in-a-lifetime case competition that allows undergraduate students from around the world to test their creative, analytical, and critical thinking skills using real-world business scenarios. Throughout the week, teams must go beyond skills and theory learned in the classroom and put their business acumen to the test by solving live and actual business cases. Their analysis will then be presented to a panel of revered industry professionals, who will carefully evaluate each presentation and determine one winning team.







SOCIAL

The city of Montreal plays a pivotal role in each year's edition of the competition. Outside of providing students with a world class case competition, one of the committee's main objectives is to give every student from our participating universities the opportunity to discover one of the world's most vibrant cities, Montreal, Quebec. COMPETITION FORMAT

JMUCC consists of three distinct stages: the 3-day Round-Robin Tournament, the 24-Hour Case, and the Final Presentations. Participating teams will have the opportunity to solve a total of 4 business cases; three 3-Hour cases and one 24-Hour case. Each case will tackle different topics and industries, offering unique challenges to the delegates. The 24 teams are randomly divided into six (6) divisions of four (4) universities. Teams will accumulate points during each round, and the university with the highest cumulative score in their respective division after all four cases will advance to the finals. The points system is further explained in the rulebook. JMUCC cases are among the most challenging and grounded in the real issues partnering organizations face.



A UNIQUE EXPERIENCE

JMUCC is more than just a competition; it is an interactive, self-driven international business event. Students, alumni, faculty across the world, and the local community alike come to watch the presentations and participate. The international community can participate online via JMUCC TV using our live streaming, multimedia content, and interactive technologies. Each day of the competition is intertwined with networking opportunities, making JMUCC a unique event for both participants and attendees.



STAGES OF COMPETITION

ROUND-ROBIN

The Round-Robin lasts three days where teams (4) within a division face-off, head-to-head, each day in a 3-hour live case. A different case is given each day, ensuring each team competes against all three other teams in its division. Judges allocate points based on solution quality, with each group receiving the number of points earned in that case. The points from the 3 cases are added for a cumulative score by the Round Robin Tournament's end. Each Round-Robin case weighs 20% of the final score (20% \times 3 = 60%).

(1) 24HR CASE

Teams get 24 hours to prepare a highly detailed solution for the fourth live case. Little information is provided on the case itself, requiring students to use their research skills and available tools (i.e., internet and textbooks) to understand the situation and propose solutions. After the deadline, teams present their solutions to a panel of business executives, who rank them within each division based on solution quality. The challenging 24-hour case offers a dynamic, enjoyable, and thrilling experience for delegates. Each team receives points based on their divisional ranking, added to the cumulative score from the Round-Robin Tournament. The 24-hour case weighs 40% of the final score, and teams with the highest cumulative score in their division will advance to the finals.

W OFINAL PRESENTATION

The final stage of JMUCC pits the best teams from each division against one another. The respective winners of each division (i.e., the teams with the highest cumulative score of the week) will move on to the final round. Immediately following the 24-Hours Case, teams will present their 24-hour case solution a second time to a new, extensive panel of prominent business executives who will ultimately decide their final rankings. Each team will start with a clean state whereby "the winner takes all," regardless of the points accumulated in the previous round. The first, second, and third place winners and the recognition awards for outstanding performances will be announced later that evening at the Closing Ceremony.



HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Located in the heart of downtown Montréal, Le Centre Sheraton Montreal Hotel comes from the best offerings in the city. All 825 comfortable and attractively appointed guest rooms and suites feature contemporary comforts, modern decor, and beautiful city views. During your stay, you will get a feel for Quebec's rich history and the city's joie de vivre. The hotel's location places you near the best shopping, dining, and entertainment along St. Catherine's Street and a short walk from the cobblestone streets of Old Montreal.

Le Centre Sheraton offers very high quality service and accommodations. You will have access to a complete fitness centre and a heated indoor pool to relax after your hard work. The hotel also offers Internet access on every floor to keep you connected and delicious foods and drinks meticulously prepared by the hotel's team of culinary professionals.

Please note that hotel accommodations will not be included in the registration fee. You will need to reserve a stay at the hotel for a total of 7 nights: Sunday, February 23rd to Sunday, March 1st, 2025. We have reserved special rates for all those participating in JMUCC 2024.

** Your hotel cost will include a full buffet breakfast from Monday to Wednesday and Friday, along with access to many of the hotel's facilities. A number of activities surrounding the competition will be taking place at Le Centre Sheraton.

Please be advised that all hotel accommodations at the Hotel "Le Centre Sheraton" must be finalized before **DECEMBER 19th, 2024**. It is mandatory to register at Le Centre Sheraton in order to participate in JMUCC. The form to have access to the training facility and the pool will be sent a week prior to the arrival of all the participants.

SELECTION PROCESS

This fall, we will be selecting 24 top-ranked Canadian and international universities to participate in this unique case competition. Universities are invited to apply for the opportunity to compete at JMUCC via e-mail, and the organizing committees will select the 2025 participating universities based on specific criteria, including presence and success in national/international case competitions, case-based curriculum, and reputation of business school. Furthermore, schools participating in JMUCC must embody our three pillars: passion, spirit and dynamism.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

To nominate your team for JMUCC, we kindly ask that you complete the registration form below the package. The application deadline is Saturday, August 31st, and universities will be notified of their application status by Friday, October 4th. Selected universities will form a team of FOUR undergraduate students and ONE faculty advisor that will attend JMUCC. Team members should know numerous business disciplines, including economics, finance, management, marketing, strategy, and international business issues.

Application Deadline: Tuesday, August 31st 2024

* Please ensure to show us in-depth how your school incorporates these values in your application, as we take this into strong consideration in our selection process.



REGISTRATION PROCESS

Once your school is selected to come to JMUCC 2025, you will receive a form to register your team and academic advisor. Before registering your delegation, we will update you with the most recent Canadian travel regulations.

If your school's delegates require a visa to enter Canada, please apply well in advance to ensure smooth travel arrangements for the JMUCC event. Don't forget to plan ahead for visa processing times. We are excited to welcome you to JMUCC!

- NAMES OF PARTICIPANTS
- Once the Organizing Committee has officially accepted your university, we will contact you to obtain the names of the participants. It is important to note that faculty advisors must submit all participants' names to the Organizing Committee by Wednesday, December 6th.
- 2 REGISTRATION FEE

 The registration fee to attend the event is CAD \$3,000 for a team of FOUR students and ONE faculty advisor. This fee will include your registration and the cost of planned activities and meals unless otherwise notified. This does not include the cost of the hotel accommodation.
- METHOD OF PAYMENT

 Once your university has been selected, the Organizing Committee will send you a document with payment instructions. To reserve your spot, you must make the first payment of CAD \$1,000 by Wednesday, November 15th 2024.

The remaining registration fee balance, CAD \$2,000, will be due by Friday, January 10th 2025.
